Ludger Kühnhardt, born 1958, has been Director at the Center for European Integration Studies (ZEI) of Bonn University since 1997. Prior to this, he was Professor of Political Science at Freiburg University, where he also served as Dean of his faculty. He has been a Visiting Professor at Stanford University, Dartmouth College, Seoul National University, St. Antony's College Oxford, College of Europe (Bruges), Cape Town University and Jena University. He regularly lectures at the Catholic University Milan (ASERI), the Diplomatic Academy Vienna and the Mediterranean Academy of Diplomatic Studies Malta. Prof. Kühnhardt was a Public Policy Scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars in Washington D.C. and has served as speechwriter for former German President Richard von Weizsäcker. A former adviser to the Secretary General of the Council of Europe and, recently, to the President of the European Parliament, he is author of more than thirty books. In 2004, he received the European Science Award of the European Foundation for Culture.
