


Fig. 7.1 The full networks of promotion. Line thickness reflects the number of awards or years on the jury.




Fig. 7.2 The cluster of Windlin and Lineto's networks amongst the insiders of the SDA 1990–2020. Line thickness reflects the number of awards or years on the jury.


