Since the beginning of 2024, the editorial team has implemented some important changes in Knowledge Organization Journal. The first change regards the submission system. Since February 1<sup>st</sup>, KO has used the Open Journal System (OJS) for all manuscript submission and review processes instead of ScholarOne.

This decision reflects our commitment to enhancing the efficiency and user experience of our submission and review workflows. OJS offers a robust and user-friendly platform that streamlines the manuscript management process for authors, reviewers, and editors. We have also updated the Instructions for authors, including examples of references and citations, to facilitate the manuscript formatting. Additionally, authors are encouraged to suggest potential reviewers for the manuscript in the Cover Letter. We believe this initiative will help assign re-

viewers more accurately, speed up the review process, and meet publication deadlines.

The editorial team is working more closely with ISKO's Scientific and Technical Advisory Council, encouraging the members to contribute to the journal and acting as reviewers and guest editors for special issues.

We are confident this transition will contribute to a smoother and more seamless publication experience for all participants.
