Hauke Ohls (PhD) is a research assistant at the Chair of Contemporary Art and Digital Image Cultures at the Institute of Art History, Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-Universität Bonn. Further, he conducted research and taught art history at the Universities of Duisburg-Essen, Trier and Aarhus. He worked as an assistant to the artist Mary Bauermeister for ten years and has been the scholarly director of her catalogue raisonné project since 2017.
