As a storytelling consultant, he has worked for institutions and companies like Microsoft, the German Federal Ministry of Environment, and the German Soccer Federation DFB, creating educational and interactive online formats. He teaches serial, transmedial, and interactive storytelling at the University of Hildesheim, the Konrad Wolf Film University of Babelsberg in Potsdam, the Film Academy of Baden-Württemberg, and the Hamburg Media School. Since 2017 he has been a professor at the International Filmschool Cologne (ifs), heading the master's program in serial storytelling.
