



WORKSHOP 2: MIGRATION AID

CHALLENGE

How might we streamline the educational path of migrant children in order to more safely transition towards formal education?

DESCRIPTION

The workshop focused on the topic of educational pathways of migrant children. The case study provided by Migration Aid helped participants to identify stakeholders in the process on a local level, analyze the current situation of relocating children in a liminal educational setting and possible pathways towards formal school education, seeking ways to help families make informed decisions. Besides social designers, socially conscious youth, changemakers and design theorists, policymakers, civil organizations and local stakeholders participated in the workshop to create a meaningful recommendation for the future that is mindful of current policy and legal barriers.
