Globalization and Knowledge Organization

This is the topic of the 6th German ISKO Conference, 23-25 September 1999 at the Hamburg Fachhochschule. Subtopics include 'Heterogeneity of Knowledge, Transfer of Knowledge, and Knowledge Aspects'. The Conference overlaps by one day (Sept. 23) with the Conference of the German Information Society (formerly German Documentation Society, DGD) also meeting at Hamburg. Foundations of Knowledge Organization, Knowledge Theory, Terminology, Ontologies, Classification Systems, Thesauri, Multimedia Knowledge Organization, Document Engineering, Data Mining, Knowledge Processing, Cognition, Scientography, Internet-ometry, Application Participation, Knowledge Management, Digital Culture.
