Gerd Kohlhepp, born in 1940, studied geography, geology, history, prehistory and economics at Universität Heidelberg, where he graduated with a Dr. phil. in 1967. In 1972 he habilitated at the faculty of geosciences at Universität Heidelberg and in the same year became a professor of human geography at Goethe-Universität Frankfurt am Main. In 1978 he was a professor of economic and social geography at Universität Tübingen, where he established a department of Latin American research. He became professor emeritus in 2005. His research in South America focused on human geography and regional socio-economic change, since the 1970s in particular on the social, economic and ecological transformations in the Brazilian Amazon region.
