Knowledge Organization (KO) deals with the inherent tension between the non-neutrality of knowledge representation and the commitment to respond promptly and accurately to the demands and information needs of different user communities. This situation has led the field of KO to engage in a discussion regarding the promotion of access and social justice through studies and actions. To this end, critical and social studies on KO, including knowledge organization systems, in archives, libraries, and information institutions must be constantly conducted. This special issue aims to explore the assumptions and values of critical and social KO approaches and welcomes theoretical and empirical paper submissions worldwide.

Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Knowledge Organization support for social justice
- Truth and Relevance in Knowledge Organization
- Inclusive terminology
- Antiracism, anticolonialism and feminist stances
- Indigenous Knowledge Organization
- Ethics in Knowledge Organization
